2 "Bubbles" of activity will be taking place.

You must be on time so that we can keep the 2 bubbles of activity separate.

Each bubble comprises of a maximum of 6 people:

- 1 Senior Instructor in a safetyboat
- Maximum of 4 Children
- Maximum of 3 Picos
- 1 volunteer for shore side support

These are **Recreational** Pico sailing sessions for cadets with RYA Stage 2 and above, or for 2 cadets in the same household where at least 1 holds an RYA Stage 2 or above.

No formal tuition will be taking place during these sessions, so sailors need to be confident to rig, launch and recover a Pico with minimal assistance from instructors.

Please sail responsibly and do not capsize deliberately so that we minimize the need for contact between dinghies and safetyboats.

Picos will be sailed from the pontoons in Mayflower Marina.

All Picos will be fitted with masthead floats to help reduce the chances of an inversion.

Safetyboats will be on the water with 1 Senior instructor on board.

Nitrile gloves will be provided so sailors can clean their boats with an eco-friendly sanitiser after use.
